## **ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY**

The Lubricant Company Group of Companies (TLC) is committed to the best practicable environmental practice in all aspects of its activities.

A Group wide Environment Management System is in operation which is designed to comply with the requirements of BS EN ISO 14001:2004. The EMS defines the commitments of the Group and environmental objectives and the effectiveness of the environmental policy are reviewed at each management review.

Specific objectives include: reduce the amount of waste to landfill, including increase the use of recycled materials; reduce the amount of energy used within the Group premises; and reduce business fuel usage and carbon dioxide emissions where possible.

Continual improvement is central to the environmental philosophy of the Group as is compliance with legislative/regulatory requirements at both national and local levels.

A series of targets to reduce the environmental impact of those aspects of the Group's operations, are established and reviewed in the Management Review meeting; this is communicated to all interested parties. Impacts evaluated as being significant have been documented. An appropriate management programme ensures that all practicable steps are taken to realise these objectives and targets.

The communication of information is available via the policy and Management Review meeting minutes to staff.

Education of suppliers, customers and interested parties, where Group knowledge and experience permits, forms an important element of the Group's commitment to this environmental policy. The Lubricant Company strives to enhance customer choice by offering synthetic or other energy saving products to reduce energy consumption and reduce waste.
